

Perth Strathtay Harriers Code of Conduct for Members

Perth Strathtay Harriers is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members (including coaches, volunteers, officials and parents) associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any compliments, concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club to the President.

As a member of Perth Strathtay Harriers you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Members must train and compete within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable clothing for training and competitions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Members are not allowed to swear on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Members should respect all coaches and parents.
- Members should respect all other athletes.

Any member who continually break these rules will be asked to leave the club.
