Runners getting lost or going wrong way on course.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A map of the Course will be on display at the race registration. • All competitors will be given a race number at the race registration and the number of starters will be counted back in as they finish. • The course will be clearly marked with red & white barrier tape, yellow direction markers and flour arrows. • Marshals will be located at key points on the course. • There will be a race briefing for runners prior to the start of the race. 	Acceptable
Duty of care to members of the public.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Runners will be advised prior to the start of the race that Kinnoull Hill is open to the public and therefore they may encounter people walking on parts of the course and to treat them with respect. • The race is in the evening, therefore the hill will be quieter. • The course will be clearly marked with red & white barrier tape for the benefit of members of the public. • Marshals will be located at parts of the course to advise members of the public what is going on. 	Acceptable
Injury	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A First aid kit will be supplied by Perth Strathtay Harriers • Perth Strathtay Harriers will provide first aid cover at the start/finish of the race and at registration (Kinnoull church hall). • Marshalls with transport will be available at two points on the course. • The course will be walked by the organisers on the afternoon of the race, marked out with red & white barrier tape and any potential hazards identified. • Runners know by the nature of the event, but will also be advised prior to the race that the course is on rough ground. • Runners will be advised on the entry form and prior to the start that they shall be solely responsible for their own safety and that Perth Strathtay Harriers will not be responsible for any injury or illness. 	Acceptable
